If you have a house listed within boundaries of the Lytle Lake Water Control and Improvement District, please be sure to communicate to potential buyers that this property has an additional property tax associated with sharing a boundary with the main body of water.

The District is comprised of about 90 homes and is governed by a 5-member Board of Directors. Members have exclusive access privileges to Lytle Lake and have a collective interest in District properties including a boat ramp off Oldham Lane, acreage north of the dam, Tittle Park and 600 acres south of Diamond Back Golf Club.

Currently, the District is managed by Heather Henderson. The mowing, maintenance and management of the District and all of its properties are paid through the annual approved budget that is funded through the LLWCID property tax.


