LAKE ACCESS FOR LYTLE WEST HOA MEMBERS:

- Lytle West HOA Members who live directly on the lake are taxpaying Lytle Lake WCID District members and have access to the lake via:
 - **Northwest Ramp off Oldham Ln.**
 - **Lakeshore Dr. Ramp**
 - **Tittle Park Ramp off of Lytle Way Circle**
- Lytle West HOA members who do not live directly on the lake, but who own a boat registered with the LLWCID have access via:
 - **Northwest Ramp off Oldham Ln.**
 - **Lakeshore Dr. Ramp.**
- Lytle West HOA members who do not live directly on the lake and who do NOT own a registered boat have access via:
 - **Lakeshore Dr. Ramp**

Boat Slip Rentals

Boat Slip rentals are available to taxpaying District members only. Rentals are \$50/ year with a \$100 initial deposit. Please contact Heather Henderson at llwcid@llwcid.org or 325.690.0835 to rent a space.

Irrigating From Lytle Lake

LLWCID taxpayers have the right to pump water from Lytle Lake to irrigate their lawns and landscapes. Residents who enjoy this privilege are encouraged to follow the City of Abilene's watering day schedules.

- When the water level in Lytle Lake drops between four and six feet from the spillway elevation, watering is restricted to two days per week. When the Lake level goes more than six feet below the spillway, the use of water from the Lake is prohibited.

😊 : Deeded Access Rights

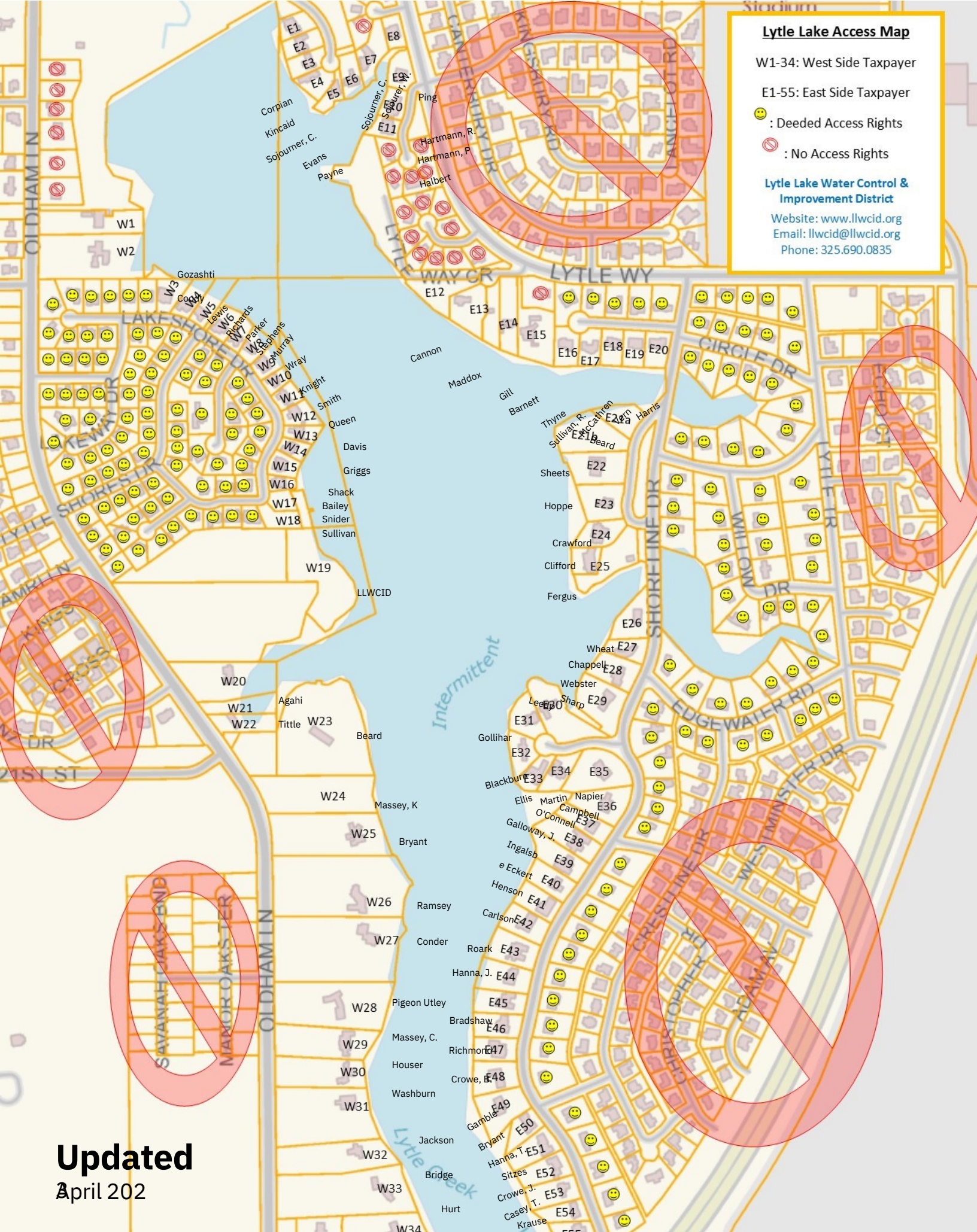
